What: Recycle MORE Minnesota, the statewide social marketing education campaign about recycling-the joint effort of the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) and the Recycling Association of Minnesota (RAM) is kicking off this Earth Day at the Minnesota Zoo's Earth Fest April 19th & 20th.

Why: Recycling in Minnesota has many economic and environmental benefits; Recycle MORE Minnesota is getting the word out about how Minnesotan's can recycle more at home, at work, and on the go. Minnesotans throw out more than 1.3 million tons (2.6 billion pounds) of material every year that could be used by Minnesota manufacturers. Our goal is to increase our recycling rate from 41% to 50% by 2011 and to do that, we need everyone to look at simple ways they can recycle more.
